# BOARDING

Students will stay in dedicated boarding houses, with **separate buildings for boys and girls**. Most rooms are shared, though individual preferences will be considered where possible.

As the program is filled with engaging group activities, time spent in rooms will be limited. Younger students will stay in dormitory-style rooms, while older students may have ensuite rooms for added privacy.

To ensure a smooth and safe experience for all participants, please review the following key details regarding our policies and campus logistics.

### 1. Refund Policy Summary

We understand that plans can change; however, as resources and staffing are committed in advance, the following policy applies:

**Withdrawal Before Start Date:** Refunds are generally not provided without a valid, school-approved reason. In exceptional cases (such as medical emergencies), requests are reviewed case-by-case, with a maximum refund limit of **MYR 8,000**.

**After Commencement / Early Departure:** Once the programme has begun, no refunds can be issued for tuition fees, early departures, or missed days.

**Process:** All requests must be submitted in writing. Approved refunds are processed within **45 working days**, and any bank or administrative charges will be deducted from the final amount.

### 2. Health, Safety, & Wellbeing

The safety of our students is our absolute priority. We provide a secure environment with professional support available at all times:

**On-Site Medical Care:** Dedicated medical staff live on-site and are available 24/7 to attend to any health needs.
